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## 2021-22 Bridgewater Raritan Regional School District Goals

 Entering the 2021/22 school year, 44% of Bridgewater-Raritan Regional students (3614 in total) have not attended school in person for eighteen months. "The Road Forward" guidance released by the New Jersey Department of Education in June 2021 states: "Local Education Agencies (LEA) must plan to provide full-day, full time, in-person instruction and operations for the 2021-22 school year."

The primary goal for the 2021-22 school year is to reacclimate students and parents into the in-person learning environment. This goal will maintain focus on the following areas.

- Health and safety of students and staff
  - Establish practices that support a layered approach to help prevent the spread of Covid-19. These practices will include:
    - General Health and Safety Guidelines
    - Cleaning, Disinfection, and Airflow
    - Screening, Exclusion, and Response to Symptomatic Students and Staff
    - Contact Tracing
    - Testing
- Provide conditions of learning that will foster the social and emotional well-being of students, families, and staff.
- Ensure equitable access and utilization of grade-level materials and high-level resources.
- Implement a K-12 Accelerated Learning Cycle to mitigate learning gaps that occurred during the pandemic.
- Develop a plan utilizing the district's additional federal and state funding allocations to support the return to full-time, in-person instruction and operations for the 2021-22 school year.
- 2. Analyze our entire physical plant to develop a facilities plan prioritizing health, wellness, safety, and positive academic outcomes within the Bridgewater-Raritan Regional School District community.
