Bridgewater-Raritan Regional School District Chain of Command

The Bridgewater-Raritan Regional School District urges parents and students to direct questions to the personnel within the organization who possesses direct knowledge of the situation at hand. Whenever a parent or student has a question, it remains a best practice to go directly to the staff member with firsthand knowledge of the situation, then proceed up the chain of command if the matter is not resolved. Adherence to the chain of command is critical for maintaining a high-functioning organization and will be implemented with fidelity by district administration.

Individual BOE members have no authority to take action in response to concerns or complaints. If the matter concerns a student or teacher, the BOE member will refer the resident to the appropriate administrator. If the matter concerns district policy or governance issues, the BOE member may ask the BOE president to place the item on the agenda of a future meeting for discussion by the full BOE.
