The program is open to all Bridgewater-Raritan resident children who are 3 and 4 years of age on or before October 1, 2022.

Applications are for general education children who are not eligible for special education and related services as a Preschool Child with a Disability. If your child meets the Kindergarten cut-off and will be 5 years of age on or before October 1, 2022, they are not eligible for our preschool program.

In an atmosphere of "we all belong," children with and without disabilities are provided with learning opportunities to facilitate academic and social success!

- Open to all Bridgewater-Raritan School District 3 and 4 year old children; must be 3 by October 1, 2022
- Program follows BRRSD District Calendar
- Start date is September 7, 2022
- Program runs 5 days per week, Monday Friday
 - o AM Session: 8:35-11:15am (subject to change)
 - o PM Session: 12:15-2:55pm (subject to change)
- Each inclusion preschool class is comprised of children with special needs and typically developing preschoolers
- Programs currently located at Adamsville, Bradley Gardens and Milltown Primary Schools (subject to change)
- Monthly Tuition \$400
- There are no AM/PM preferences children will be chosen for a slot determined by the staff looking at homeschool location, gender and age
- Transportation is currently NOT provided. Families are responsible for transporting children to and from the program daily
- Lottery Applications for general education children due by February 1, 2022 - 3:00pm
- Lottery drawing February 4, 2022
- Families will be notified of lottery number and AM or PM session assignment via email by February 11, 2022.
- Once a student is in the program, he/she may remain in the program until reaching Kindergarten age (turns 5 by October 1 of the current school year - Board Policy 5111)
- Children will return to their homebase school for kindergarten
- Siblings each sibling requires an application
