Guidelines

There will be two categories:

 - 2. Hillside Staff

There will be four coveted "GOLDEN SPOON" prizes for the top tip earners and best in show! The winner will also receive a digital cookbook of all the recipes submitted and an exclusive, limited edition, never-before-been-seen Roots & Shoots reusable water bottle!

- Chef participants will "host" their own cooking show (Or with a friend or family member) to display their favorite dishes. The final chefs that are chosen will be sharing their best culinary recipes with students and their families.
- The event starts at 6:00 pm.
- Once you have turned in your permission form (Permission Form for Virtual Celebrity Chef), you will be contacted with a FlipGrid code. Submissions to be considered as a finalist should be made through FlipGrid. Your FlipGrid video should include your name, your dish, and how to prepare it. Why should the judges choose it? What makes it unique? You will have three minutes for the video. Chefs may choose to prepare an appetizer, main dish, dessert, etc. We encourage you to use eco-friendly products.
- The Roots & Shoots Committee will narrow down the submissions to ten student finalists and five staff finalists. These finalists will have their videos showcased at our virtual event on December 14th.
- Tips will start being collected at the live event, and continue to be collected throughout the week of December 14th.

- You may decorate your space, wear costumes, and include any other "bells and whistles" to attract tippers.
- Students should submit their permission form by November 23rd and video submission by December 2nd.

Please remember that this event is a fundraiser. The ultimate goal is to raise as much money as possible, while having fun. We had over 500 people attend and participate previously, and we would love to keep that tradition alive.
